

Dear High School Parents,

Our district uses Securly to keep students safe on their school-issued devices.

As part of the solution, we are enabling access for parents to the **free SecurlyHOME** app and Parent Portal view **during the week of October 31st 2018**. If your student is actively using their school issued device, you'll start to receive a weekly email report with samples of your child's online activity over the previous week. This email will have a link to download SecurlyHOME (remember to check your spam/junk folder).

You will be able to change the filtering preferences on your students device while the device is not at the district. Block specific sites, block categories, etc.

To get Started:

Step 1: Get the Email

Keep your eyes peeled for the email in your inbox from support@securly.com.

Step 2: Download the SecurlyHOME App or Go to

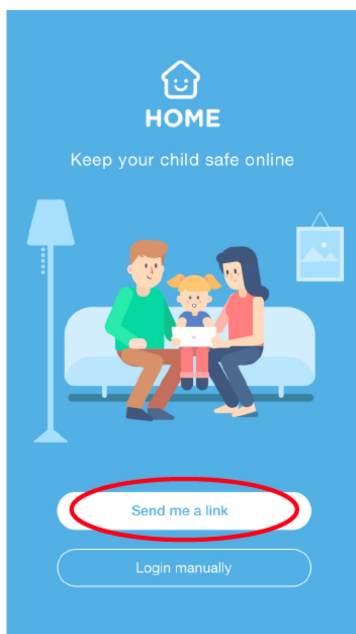
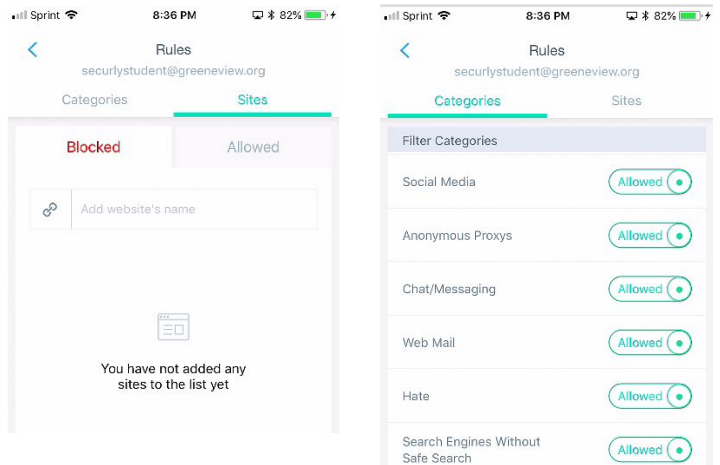

Tap the white button to get started. A link will be sent to the email address you have registered with your child's school.



****If you don't have an email on file or need to update your email address please make sure to update your email address in the "Oneview Parent Portal"**

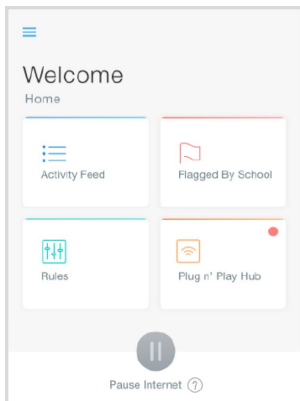

Once you've clicked the link, you'll be taken into the SecurlyHOME App. Your account is ready to go!

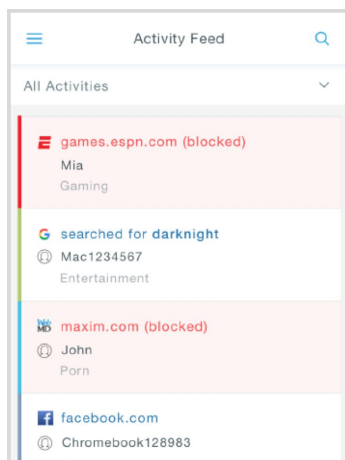
Step 3: Explore and Configure

SecurlyHOME lets you access your account information from anywhere, in real-time.



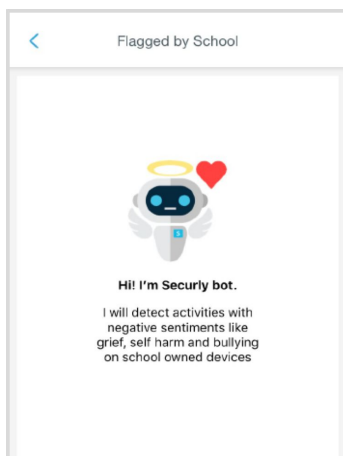
1. Get Started
